- Provide a platform for regional and international youth engagement.

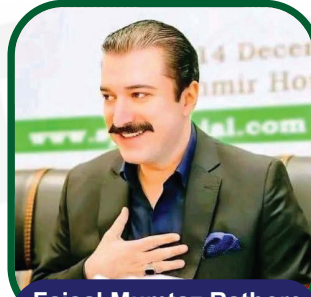

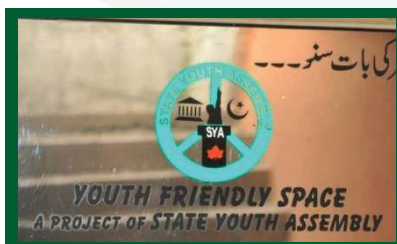
LEARN TO LEAD

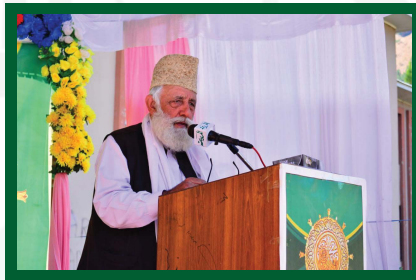
